- 1. PRESIDENTS'S HOOK-UP (Zoom) 8/10/20 National Fleece Competition good sponsorship so far (covering costs). Video of judging and procedures will be made. IAR rules being reviewed. Amanda doing monthly newsletter so update from each region needed. National Portal set up as repository for information – some items have gone in already. Finances still on track due to members sales of animals and transfers. Treasurers hook-up with Amanda – general update and Q&A. National Travelling Display is getting old but still being used but a lot less as it is outdated and worn. Looking for new owner so can possibly recoup some money. Colour Genetics webinar by Kylie Munyard-possibly might be available more widely. An Animal Health webinar by Jane Vaughan coming soon. Considering setting up more but need to look into costs etc. Website – this type of material should only be available to members with skim information only to visitors to site. Fee structure review (but not disclosed at meeting, starts 1/1/21) will be out very soon and should take into account what people are doing by not being members for several years to save costs. NLIS group - have selected tag but have been told they are not allowed to use it as its a cattle tag so could infringe on copyright/regs??? Is RFID and Visual type. LLI – more needed for alpaca industry – very little notice given by Sarah Wheeler, L Sadler already Industry Liason, JP will also do the training as its on very short notice. E-Alpaca – 5vr renewal achieved but AAA own the data but not the system. If contractor goes broke then we own it. Nathan has admitted that the costings for buying/development still hasn't broken even to date. Q Fever test being finalised for direct export access to UK ie quicker/cheaper than via NZ. Lower density for stock crate numbers was mooted however impractical to export and not financially viable and could have had repercussions on domestic travel via vans/floats/trailers. One state having a 'mock' show in Jan/Feb. One region sponsoring fleeces to National Show ie pay transporting fees for up to 5 fleeces per stud.

RAS – Nothing to report as no meeting since last committee meeting.

COLOUR CLASSIC- Nothing to report

STRATHALBYN – Nothing to report.

<u>EVENTS</u>: Shearing Workshop – Cancelled. Only 4 responses but they were not interested in learning to shear just seeing different methods/styles. Maybe try again in 2021? As an aside – cost of sheep shearing has risen due to movement restrictions of shearers around states/OS.
